

IOCL awards EPCM Services contract for Panipat Refinery Expansion

Indian Oil Corporation Limited has awarded us a contract to provide Engineering, Procurement and Construction Management (EPCM) services for various units of their refinery located in Panipat in northern India.

The EPCM 2 and EPCM 3 assignments are part of the P-25 project which Indian Oil is implementing in expansion of their Panipat Refinery from 15 MMTPA to 25 MMTPA over the next four years. The project is targeted to be completed by 2024.

The scope of services includes engineering, procurement, construction management for the INDMAX (FCC) Unit, Gasoline Splitter unit (GSU), MS-Block (NHT-CCR & ISOM Unit) and SR LPG Treater Unit under the EPCM 2 Package while for the EPCM 3 Package, similar services are included for the Polypropylene Unit (PPU) and the Catalytic Dewaxing Unit (CDW) including all associated utilities within the units and relevant interfaces with the offsite facilities.

The project, which was won in a competitive bidding process, is the latest in a long line of projects we are implementing for the oil refining major.

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
