**Important !**

This declaration can not provide evidence of origin for obtaining a movement certificate EUR.1 or EUR-MED  
being used in preferential trade between the European Community and certain countries. For these pur-  
poses a "Supplier's declaration for products having preferential origin status" as per council regulation (EC)  
No. 1207/2001 is mandatory.

Footnotes serve as explanation only :

- 1) Description.
- 2) Commercial designation as used on the invoice, e. g. Model No.
- 3) Name of company to which goods are supplied.
- 4) Only one option to be used. Exception: Whenever products having Community/Union origin are supplied together with products origination outside the Community, the proper country of origin has to be shown clearly on the invoice or another document.
- 5) Country of origin (member state of the European Community/European Union).
- 6) Country of origin (state outside the European Community/European Union). Only in these cases a certification by the CCI is required. The origin has to be proven by appropriate documents.
- 7) ~~To be filled in only when used as long term declaration. The period of time must not exceed 12 months.~~
- 8) The supplier's local Chamber of commerce and industry.
- 9) These are proofs which are also required for issuing a certificate of origin.
